3. DURING A MEETING WITH PRIME MINISTER THATCHER ON THE  
AFTERNOON OF APRIL 15 I RAISED WITH HER OUR CONCERNS  
OVER THE DANISH FOLKETING'S RESOLUTION ON APRIL 14  
CONCERNING SHIP VISITS.

4. IN OTHER EMBASSY CONTACTS WITH HMG DURING THE DAY,  
WE LEARNED THAT THE DANISH SHIP VISIT ISSUE CAME UP  
DURING THE FCO'S DAILY PRESS BRIEFING AT 12:30. IN  
REPLY TO REPORTERS' QUESTIONS, THE FCO SPOKESMAN SAID:

"WE ARE AWARE OF THE RESOLUTION TAKEN BY THE DANISH  
PARLIAMENT YESTERDAY, AND WE ARE IN TOUCH WITH THE  
DANISH GOVERNMENT. WE UNDERSTAND THAT THE DANISH  
PRIME MINISTER HAD SAID THAT THE DANISH GOVERNMENT WOULD  
BE CONSULTING THEIR NATO PARTNERS IN THE COURSE OF THE  
NEXT TEN DAYS. IT REMAINS BRITISH GOVERNMENT POLICY  
NEITHER TO CONFIRM NOR DENY THE PRESENCE OF NUCLEAR  
WEAPONS IN ANY PARTICULAR LOCATION."
