 EMBASSY SHOULD RESPOND TO THE CIRCULAR NOTE IT RECEIVED JUNE 8 (REFTEL) WITH THE FOLLOWING AIDE-MEMOIRE TO THE MFA.

2. BEGIN TEXT:

THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA PRESENTS ITS COMPLIMENTS TO THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND HAS THE HONOR TO REFER TO THE MINISTRY'S CIRCULAR NOTE DATED JUNE 7, 1988 CONCERNING VISITS OF FOREIGN WARSHIPS TO DENMARK.

WITH REFERENCE TO THE MINISTRY'S NOTE, THE EMBASSY WISHES TO CALL TO THE ATTENTION OF THE MINISTRY THE OFFICIAL STATEMENT MADE IN WASHINGTON ON JUNE 7, 1988

AT THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE ON THIS SUBJECT, WHICH STATED THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA HAS NOTED THE JUNE 7 STATEMENT IN PARLIAMENT BY PRIME MINISTER POUL SCHLUETER ON THE QUESTION OF SHIP VISITS TO DENMARK AND ALSO NOTED THE RELATED STATEMENT BY FOREIGN MINISTER ELLEMANN-JENSEN ON THE SAME DATE THAT "THE DANISH GOVERNMENT CONSIDERS THAT THIS PROCEDURE RESPECTS THE POLICY OF OUR ALLIES—NEITHER TO-CONFIRM NOR TO DENY THE PRESENCE OF NUCLEAR VEAPONS ON THEIR NAVAL VESSELS."

THE U.S. STATEMENT ANNOUNCED THAT AFTER REVIEWING THESE TWO STATEMENTS, AND AFTER CONSULTATIONS WITH THE

GOVERNMENT OF DENMARK AND WITH KEY ALLIES, THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT HAS CONCLUDED THAT THE DANISH WANDLING OF THE SHIP VEST 1939E DOES NOT INFRINGE UPON THE POLICY OF MUTHER SCHIFTING NOR DENYING THE PRESENCE OF NUTLEAR HE FORS BOORD U.S. NAVAL VESSELS.

THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AVAILS ITSELF OF THIS OPPORTUNITY TO RENEW TO THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS THE ASSURANCE OF ITS HIGHEST CONSIDERATION.
